

## JEANNE C. HARRY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM DETAILS AND APPLICATION

As a benefit for chapter service, Tucson / Southern Arizona Chapter encourages its CPM<sup>®</sup> Candidate and Associate members to complete their education and obtain the CPM<sup>®</sup> Designation. It is recognized that IREM<sup>®</sup> Courses require a time and financial commitment, which may be difficult for some members to satisfy. For that reason, IREM<sup>®</sup> Tucson / Southern Arizona Chapter periodically makes funds available to assist in completing a portion of the required education.

### **CPM<sup>®</sup> Scholarship Requirements**

To be considered for this local chapter scholarship, the applicant must:

- Complete and submit the attached application form
- Be member of Tucson/ Southern Arizona Chapter in good standing

### **CPM<sup>®</sup> Scholarship Terms and Considerations:**

- Scholarships are awarded for any course sponsored by IREM<sup>®</sup>
  - On-Line and Home Study courses
  - Classroom courses out of state
  - Classroom courses hosted by the Tucson/ Southern Arizona Chapter
  - Scholarship awards can be up to 100% of the course fee, based on funds availability
- Scholarships are not limited
- Apply multiple times during a single year
  - Previous denial does not imply future denial; previous award does not imply future award
- In the event application requests exceed funding capability, the Executive Council will review the applications and make final award decisions based on:
  - Previous award history
  - Chapter engagement
  - Courses completed at time of application
  - This policy can be amended at any time by the Executive Council. Exceptions to this policy can be made at the discretion of the Executive Council.
