

JEANNE C. HARRY SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION

Tucson-Southern Arizona Chapter encourages its members to complete their education and obtain the CPM[®], ARM[®] or ACoM[®] certification. It is recognized that IREM[®] courses require time and financial commitment, which may be difficult for some members to satisfy. For that reason, IREM Tucson-Southern Arizona Chapter periodically makes funds available to assist in completing a portion of the required education.

CPM[®] Scholarship Requirements

To be considered for this local chapter scholarship, the applicant must:

- Complete and submit the Jeanne C. Harry application.
- Be a member of Tucson-Southern Arizona Chapter in good standing and current with dues.
- Attend 2 IREM Chapter events.
- Participate on one Chapter Committee.

CPM[®] Scholarship Terms and Considerations

- Scholarships are awarded for any CPM/ARM, ACoM course sponsored by IREM.
 - Online and self-paced CPM/ARM/ACoM courses.
 - Classroom courses hosted by the Tucson-Southern Arizona or Phoenix Chapter.
 - Scholarship awards will be reviewed by the Tucson Board of Directors and are based on fund availability.
- Scholarships are for IREM members.
- In the event an application request exceeds funding awarded, the Board of Directors will review the application and make final award decisions based on:
 - Previous award history
 - Chapter engagement
 - Courses completed at time of application
- This policy can be amended at any time by the IREM Tucson-Southern Arizona Chapter Board of Directors. Exceptions to this policy can be made at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
